

# PUA0PE017A COORDINATE RESOURCES FOR A MULTI-AGENCY INCIDENT

## COURSE OVERVIEW

This course comprises one nationally recognised unit of competency providing learners with the skills and knowledge required to bring together organisations and other resources to support an incident. Incidents that require such resource coordination are typically Level 3 incidents, which are characterised by degrees of complexity that may require the establishment of divisions for effective management of the situation. These incidents will usually involve delegation of all functions.

## UNITS OF STUDY

The training course comprises of one unit of competency:

### PUA0PE017A Coordinate resources for a multi-agency incident

This unit applies to people who perform the role of emergency coordination at a Level 3 incident. The authorisation to perform this role is subject to emergency state/territory emergency management arrangements. This unit also covers the systematic acquisition and application of organisational, human and equipment resources in an incident.



## DURATION OF STUDY

The duration of this training course is 2 consecutive days in a classroom delivery (face-to-face). Please note there will be a number of assessments which will need to be completed post course to be submitted for competency.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This course is intensive and you will be asked to complete a brief pre-entry assessment to determine your suitability to complete this training course. It is important that learners wishing to complete this course are mature aged students who have emergency management responsibilities within their workplace or volunteer role. Additionally, learners also need to be mature aged students who have completed secondary schooling and/or completed other qualifications.

## FUTURE PATHWAYS

The unit PUAOPE017A Coordinate resources for a multi-agency incident can be used as a core unit towards the PUA60112 Advanced Diploma of Public Safety (Emergency Management) qualification.

## TRAINING DELIVERY
