PUAEMR018A Work in an Emergency Management Context

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Level 1 Incident Management course consists of one nationally recognised unit of competency developed for personnel who may be required to:

- perform a role within emergency management and
- be informed of incident management underpinning principles and concepts.

The underpinning knowledge and concepts of incident management, such as AIIMS and ICCS, will be a focus throughout the course.

UNITS OF STUDY

The Level 1 Incident Management course comprises the following unit of competency:

PUAEMR018A Work in an Emergency Management Context

This unit applies to people who are undertaking, or are preparing to work in, an emergency management role within their organisation and/or local community and require a broad understanding of the jurisdiction's emergency management framework in order to undertake their work responsibilities.



DURATION OF STUDY

The duration of this training course is 2 consecutive days in a classroom delivery (face-to-face). Please note there will be a number of assessments which will need to be completed post course to be submitted for competency.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This course is intensive and you will be asked to complete a brief pre-entry assessment to determine your suitability to complete this training course. It is important that learners wishing to complete this course are mature aged students who have emergency
